COMPETITION OUTLINE

The QCSA STATE TITLES is an annual event held to showcase the talent in our Association and allow teams to compete at the highest level of Christian Soccer in Queensland.

Recognising the highest quality players in our Association is the task of our State Coaching Staff, who will select participants to compete at the AUSTRALIAN CHRISTIAN SOCCER TITLES in select age groups.

The QCSA State Titles competition allows each zone or affiliate team to play against other zonal and affiliated teams nominated in their age group, recognising teams may not play all other zones and/or affiliate teams depending on the draw.

For the purpose of the 2018 QCSA STATE TITLES, it is recognised that our largest affiliate Association, the Sunshine Coast, is divided into two zones known as Sunshine Coast North and Sunshine Coast South. All other affiliates are entered as an individual entity North, South East and West.

This competition supports the Fair Play guidelines as set out by the QCSA and FIFA FAIR PLAY.

All teams, coaches, managers and spectators are to compete within the spirit of these guidelines at all times both on and off the field.

The QCSA State Titles organising committee reserves the right to alter the competition program, ground, or match times at any time during the competition.

Notification of these changes will be given to the zone coordinators affected by the change. It will be the responsibility of this person to ensure the information is forwarded to all the teams involved.

QCSA AGE GROUP STATE TROPHIES

In 2018 the QCSA STATE TITLES will be conducted in the following age groups:

Under 10	Under 16 Girls
Under 11	Under 16 Boys
Under 12	Under 18 Men
Under 13	Senior Women
Under 14	Senior Men

The winner of each age group will be decided at the completion of all games for that age group.

The method to be used for each age group is at the discretion of the organising committee and shall be advised prior to the commencement of competition.

Results and progress tables for each age group as well as aggregate trophy and shield standings will be updated periodically and available for view at the administration area of the facility.

The following points are awarded for each match.

Win – 4 Points

Score Draw – 2 Points

Nil All Draw – 1 Point

Loss – 0 Points

In the event of a forfeit, the non-forfeiting team will receive 4 Points and 3 goals for. The forfeiting team will receive no points and will also be required to attend a discipline hearing along with their respective zone or affiliate to answer charges of bringing the QCSA into disrepute.

Should a match be abandoned for any reason the QCSA Representative Football Coordinator shall chair an organisational committee meeting, to decide the outcome of the match and any further actions deemed necessary. This decision will be final with no rights of appeal.

FOR ALL AGE GROUP COMPETITIONS IN 2018 at the end of all games played, the points for each zone team will be totaled and the team with the highest number of points will be declared the Age Group State Champions.

In the event that two or more teams have the same number of points the State Champion will be determined by (in order of priority) goal difference, then most wins, then most goals scored, then relevant result against other joint team. Should two teams still be equal then they will be declared Joint Age State Champions.

THE AGGREGATE TROPHIES

Zones and affiliates will be awarded aggregate points on the basis of the outcome of each of the Age State Champion competitions.

Points are awarded as follows:

Age Champion – 4 Points
3rd Place – 2 Points

Runners up – 3 Points
4th Place – 1 Point

If in any particular age group teams are declared joint champions, both teams will receive 3.5 points, there will be no points awarded for the second place; next place will be third place receiving 2 points and 1 point for fourth place.

In age groups where a zone has more than one team participating, only the highest placed team in that particular age group will receive aggregate points towards any or all aggregate awards.

In deciding the winners of all aggregate trophies (QCSA STATE CHAMPION TROPHY (ERIC JONES CUP), MAROOCHY SHIRE BICENTENNIAL TROPHY, AIS SENIOR TROPHY, and U BEAUT TROPHIES JUNIOR TROPHY) should two or more zones be level on points, then the zone with a superior goal difference will decide the winner. If they are still level, the zone with the most goals scored will be declared the winner.

QCSA STATE CHAMPION TROPHY – THE ERIC JONES CUP

Eric Jones was the founding president of the QCSA in 1968. Fifty years later, and Eric is still very much an active part of our Association through his work with the Blackstone Welsh Soccer Club.

The winner of THE ERIC JONES CUP will be the zone that receives the highest number of aggregate points over all the age competitions.

A I S SENIOR CUP

The Winner of the AUSTRALIAN INSURANCE SOLUTIONS SENIOR CUP will be the zone that receives the highest number of points over all SENIOR competitions held at the tournament.

U BEAUT TROPHIES JUNIOR CUP

The Winner of the U BEAUT TROPHIES JUNIOR CUP will be the zone that receives the highest number of points over all JUNIOR competitions held at the tournament.

MAROOCHY SHIRE BICENTENNIAL TROPHY

The Maroochy Shire Bi-Centennial Trophy is to be awarded to the Champion team. The Champion Team is the team gaining the highest percentage points. The percentage points will be calculated by dividing the points gained by the points achievable in each age group and multiplying same by 100.

ZONE GOAL DIFFERENCE TROPHY

The ZONE GOAL DIFFERENCE TROPHY is presented to the Zone with the highest goal difference for the State Titles.

For each Zone, all the goals scored will be totaled (across all age groups) and all the goals conceded will be deducted from that total.

The Zone with the highest positive goal difference will be declared the winner. If any Zones are equal on goal difference, they will be declared joint winners.

BEST TEAM GOAL AVERAGE TROPHY

The BEST TEAM GOAL AVERAGE is awarded to the team that has the BEST GOAL AVERAGE (HIGHEST) achieved by the total number of goals scored divided by matches played. If two teams are equal then the team with the best goal average AND the lowest against goal

average shall be declared the winner. If two or more teams are still equal then the teams will be declared joint winners.

QCSA STATE TITLE AGE CHAMPION TROPHIES

SCM decided that as new life members were accepted by the Association, they would be revered by having a QCSA State Titles Champion Trophy named in their honour. To date, the following have all had this accolade bestowed upon them:

- Cliff Phillips (Under 13);
- Leonie McAneney (Senior Women); and
- Tony Scarcella (Under 16 Boys).

COMPETITION RULES

The same competition rules apply to the QCSA 2018 STATE TITLES as they do for the normal QCSA competition and these are available on the QCSA website www.qcsa.org.au. Club skins may be worn for the QCSA STATE TITLES competition in 2018.

An exception is that you are allowed to put 16 players on a match card for any one game (instead of the usual 15 players). Same interchange rules apply as normal QCSA competition.

Any yellow cards that are accrued during the QCSA 2018 STATE TITLES do not carry over into the normal QCSA competition. However, penalties that cannot be served and completed in total within the structure of the STATE TITLES will carry over into the QCSA Fixture Competition. 3 yellows across 3 games = 1 red card.

Any red cards given out during the QCSA 2018 STATE TITLES, will be dealt with during this competition, in the fact that players will be suspended from matches for how many games the offence committed is deemed worthy by discipline. Serious offences will be dealt with by an appropriate Discipline Panel convened specifically for that purpose. If this suspension carries over into the normal QCSA competition, you will miss the relevant amount of matches in the QCSA competition.

Any official, coach, manager, player, spectator or neutral person not adhering to the rules of the competition as accepted by QCSA, or not acting within the spirit of these rules will be dealt with by QCSA in the first instance. Further action where deemed necessary will be taken in all cases.

GUIDELINES FOR ZONES AND ASSOCIATIONS & PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

1. Introduction:

- 1.1 The QCSA State Titles is an annual event to showcase the talent in our association and allow teams to compete at the highest level of Christian soccer/football in Queensland.
- 1.2 The QCSA State Titles are open to the three Zones within the QCSA; North, West and South-East as well as all affiliates of the QCSA and can include other Christian football bodies upon application to the QCSA.
- 1.3 The QCSA reserves the right to invite/issue an invitation to other teams as deemed appropriate.

2. Team numbers:

- 2.1 Each zone or association may field two teams per age group.
- 2.2 Under 10 to under 16 boys and girls teams are permitted 16 players per team.
- 2.3 Under 18, Ladies and Men are permitted a maximum of 20 players per team.
- 2.4 Each team is permitted to play a maximum of 16 players per match.

3. Player eligibility:

- 3.1 All players MUST be a registered player of the QCSA, its affiliates or the Christian football body they represent. Each zone is required to verify that each player is a registered

player of a current QCSA club or SCCSA Club and playing in the correct age group for State Titles.

- 3.2 ALL players MUST have been registered in 2018 with their respective clubs and have been playing in ALL eligible rounds in the current season prior to the State Titles to be eligible to play at State Titles.
- 3.3 Players must play in their correct age group as what age they are at 31st December of the year prior to the State Titles (regardless of what age group they play for in the QCSA or SCCSA fixtures competition. *i.e.*, if a player is 12 as of 31/12/17 then they play in Under 13 for State Titles.

3.4 Players are NOT permitted to play DOWN an age group, under any circumstances.

3.5 Players can only play up an age group if:

(a) Your zone does not form a team in the age group

(b) There are surplus players for one team, but insufficient to form a second team in that particular age. There is no restriction on the number of players that can play up an age group.

(c) In the case of a zone or association not forming a team or having insufficient players to form two teams in an age group or, the player cannot move up an age group into a team, the player/s is/are permitted to try out for selection in another zone or association.

3.6 Players currently suspended in the QCSA Fixture competition, its affiliated competitions (SCCSA) or the Christian football body they represent (Baptist), who as of Thursday 3rd May 2018, have two (2) or more weeks left of any suspension are not allowed to take part in the 2018 State Titles competition. *.i.e.*, if a player received a three (3) week suspension two (2) weeks before aforementioned date, they are fine to play, **BUT, if a player received a four (4) week suspension two (2) weeks before the aforementioned date they are not allowed to play.**

4. Uniforms:

Every team within each Zone is to wear the same coloured uniform. If a zone has 2 (two) teams in the same age group, then they are to have 1 (one) alternate strip for wearing by 1 (one) team when they play against each other only. The alternate strip is not to be worn for any other matches against other zones.

- Southeast Zone: Red and Blue
- North Zone: Light Blue and White
- West Zone: Bottle Green and Yellow
- Sunshine Coast: Yellow and Black
